

RESOLUTION

2006-R-24

AN AMENDMENT TO RESOULUTION 2006-R-24 OPPOSING THE EXPANSION OF NATURAL GAS STORAGE AT LAKE PEIGNEUR IN INBERIA PARISH, LOUISIANA WHICH WAS ADOPTED ON MARCH 20, 2006.

WHEREAS, the Vermilion Parish Police Jury adopted Resolution on March 20, 2006; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury to amend Resolution 2006-R-24 to oppose the expansion of natural gas storage in the Jefferson Island salt domes by any party, on both the Federal and State levels, so as preserve the quantity and quality of water available from the aquifer for current and future generations, and because of other potential environmental impacts from said natural gas storage;

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury that it opposes the expansion of natural gas in the Jefferson Island salt domes by any party, on both the Federal and State levels, so as preserve the quantity and quality of water available from the aquifer for current and future generations, and because of other potential environmental impacts from said natural gas storage.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of Resolution 2006-R-24shall remain the same.
